FMVSS 110 Compliance Information

All dealers must determine if the Net weight they have added in the form of all options or accessories, when added to the weight of all Port/Dealer Installed options or accessories, exceeds the lesser of 1.5% of GVWR or 100 lbs. If the additional weight does exceed the lesser of the indicated thresholds, a "Load Carrying Capacity Reduced" label must be installed. A black, fine-point, indelible marker must be used to write by hand onto the label, the reduced carrying capacity in kilograms or pounds, which is the total weight of all added options and accessories.

Warning! Ensure that each All-Season Fitted Liner is securely attached to the vehicle's floor mat anchor(s) before driving the vehicle. This helps keep the All-Season Fitted Liner from sliding forward. If the All-Season Fitted Liner slips and interferes with the movement of the pedals during driving, it may cause an accident.


Do not put an additional Floor Liner/Mat on top of the anchored All-Season Fitted Liner, otherwise the additional Liner/Mat may slide forward and interfere with the movement of the pedals.

Notes to the installer:

- 1) Dealer must clearly advise customer of installation method.
- 2) Before installing, verify and identify all parts.
- 3) Remove vinyl factory covering from carpeted areas before installation.
- 4) Sliding driver and passenger seats to furthest rearward position provides better access to install front All-Season Fitted Liners properly.
- 5) When removing mats or liners, be sure to hold grommet and mat/liner at the same time, then pull rearward to unhook.








N O T E	<p>A. Before installation, remove all floor mats/liners from the front and rear of the vehicle.</p> <p>B. Starting with the left front driver's side floor area, make sure it is clean and that the retention hooks are properly attached to the floor carpet.</p>

N O T E	<p>A. Install the Left (Driver) Front All-Season Fitted Liner by placing the front portion under the brake pedal area and allow the liner to gently fall into place.</p>

N O T E	<p>NOTE: Some vehicles may not have rear retention hook(s) protruding from the vehicle floor.</p> <p>A. Align the holes in the All-Season Fitted Liner with the retention hooks protruding from the vehicle floor. Install the All-Season Fitted Liner onto the retention hook(s) and push down to lock into place.</p> <p>B. Repeat steps 1-3 to install the passenger side All-Season Fitted Liner.</p> <p>C. If rear liners are included in the set, repeat steps 1-3 to install the rear All-Season Fitted Liners. Rear Retention Hooks are included on some models.</p>

Care & Cleaning

Cleaning Instructions for:

MULTIPLE

All-Season Fitted Liners

Each All-Season Fitted Liner can easily be cleaned using a vacuum, soft cloth, or soft brush.

To remove excess dirt, use water with a mild detergent to clean the liner. Do not use bleach or alcohol to clean the liner or the liner may become damaged or discolored.

Dry the liner with a soft cloth or place the liner in a well ventilated area to dry before reinstalling. If the liner is installed before it is completely dry, it could become moldy or emit an abnormal smell.

Do not place the liner on the ground where it is in direct contact with the sun, or the liner could deform from high temperatures.

Do not use a washing machine or automatic mat cleaner to clean the liner. The liner could become damaged and/or deformed.
