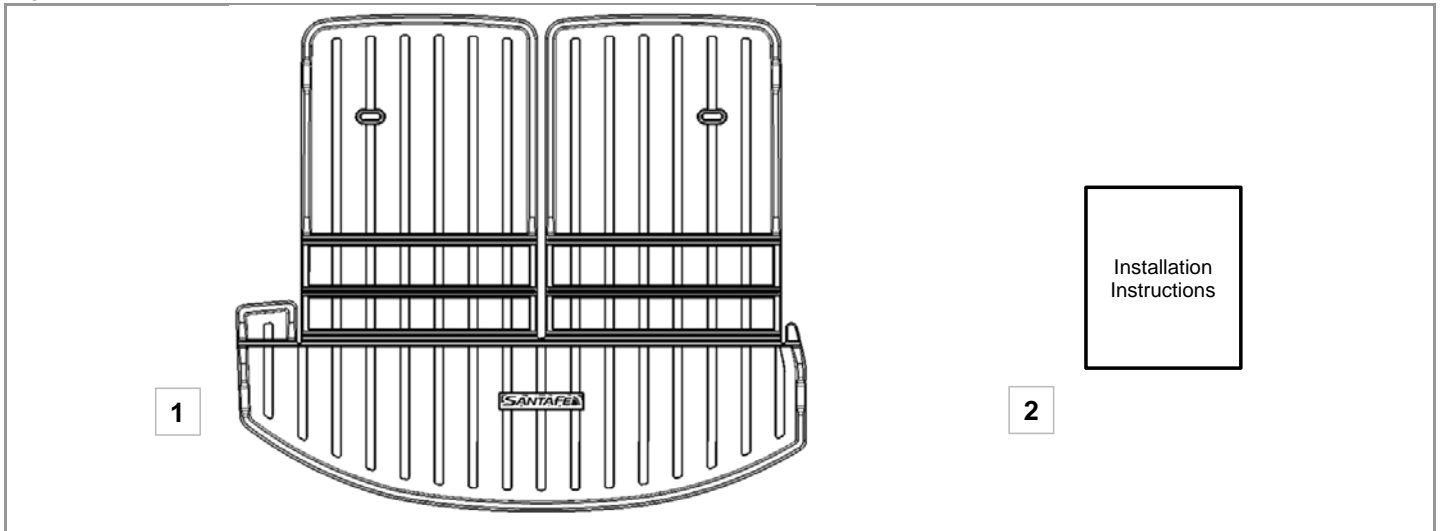

- Place these instructions in the glove box after the installation is complete.

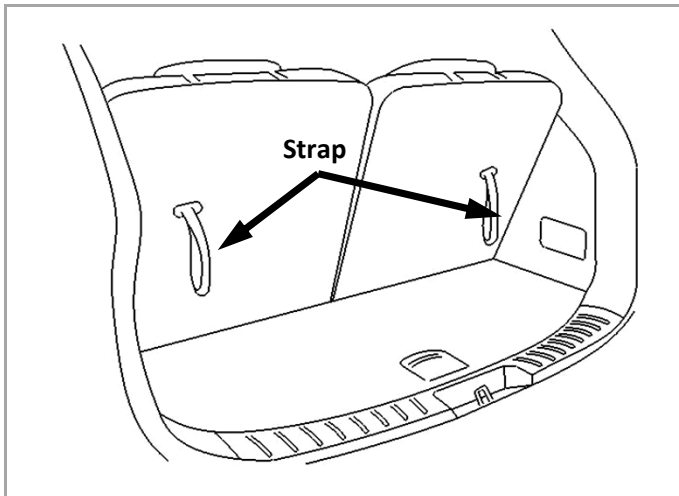

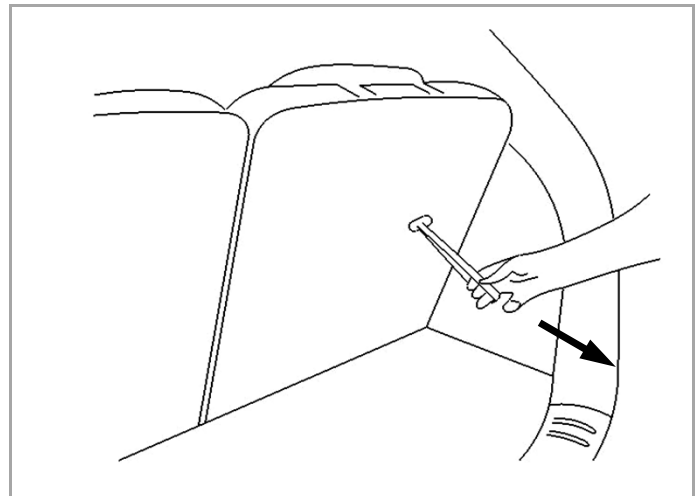

1. Open the rear lift gate and locate the straps on the seatbacks.

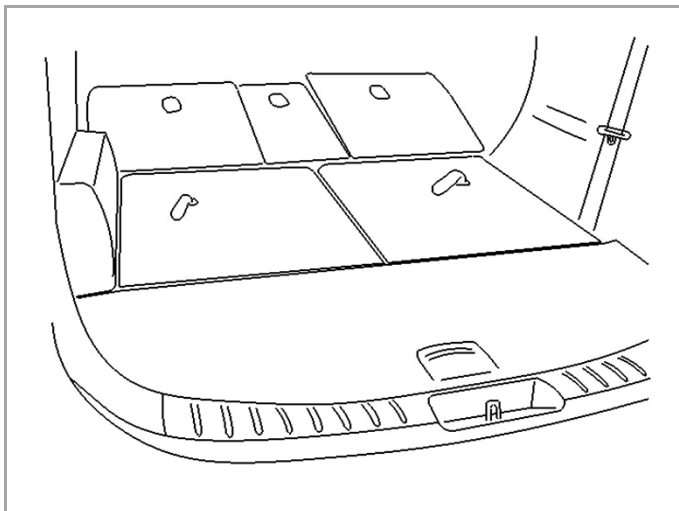

1. Starting with the passenger side, pull the strap to lower the seatback fully forward.
2. Repeat on the driver side.

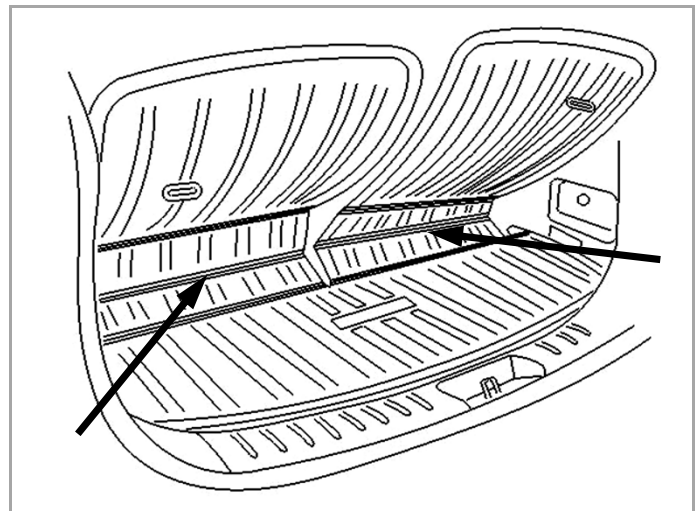

1. Fold the driver and passenger rear seatbacks fully forward to a level position with the cargo area.

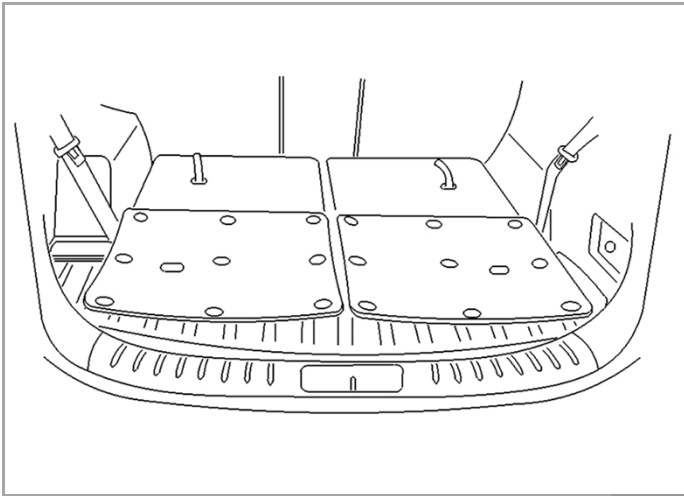

1. Fold the cargo tray at the hinges and install into the vehicle cargo area as shown.

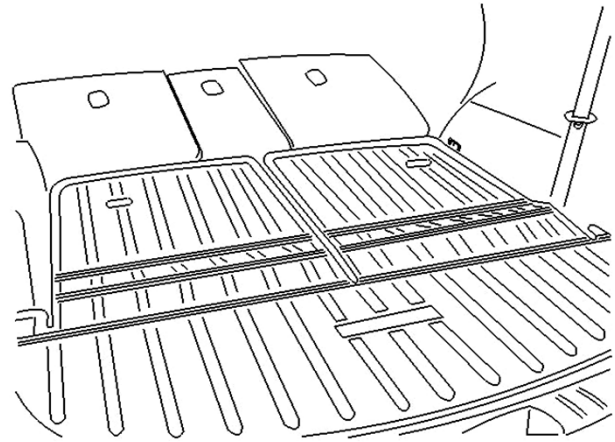

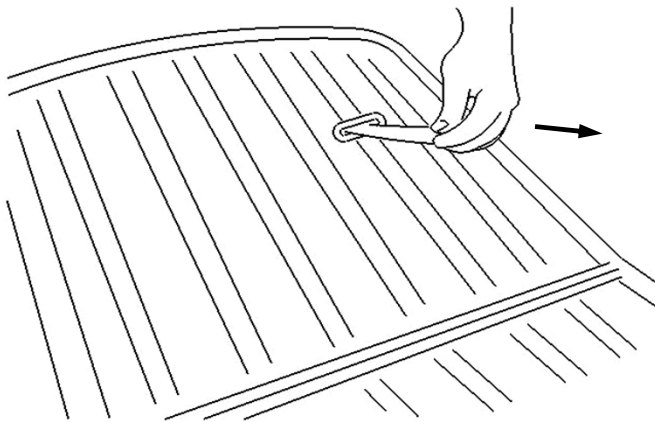
1. With the folded panels facing up, align the bottom portion of the carpeted tray with the contours of the cargo area as shown.

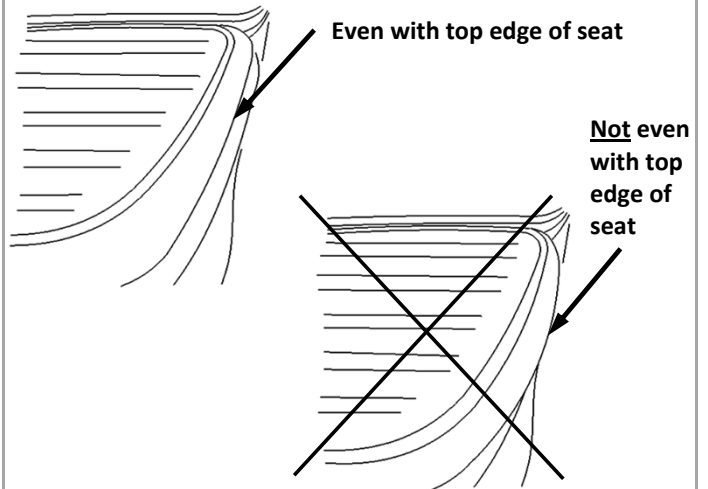
1. Unfold the driver and passenger panels of the cargo tray and lay them flat on the seatback.

1. Insert the passenger side pull strap through the cutout in the tray as shown.
2. Repeat for the driver side.

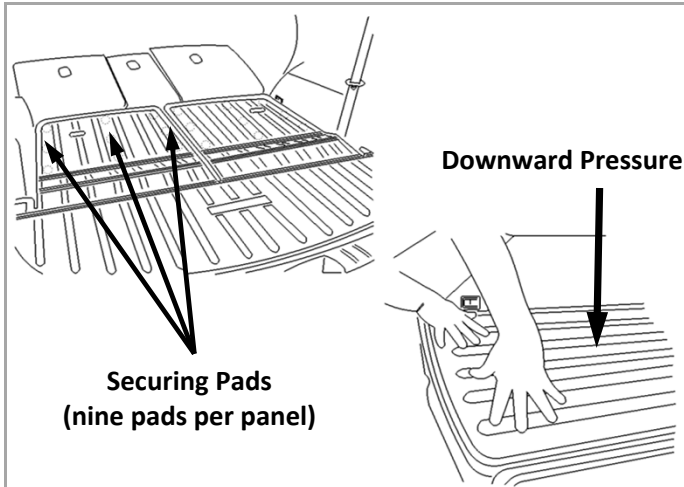

NOTE

1. With the straps in place align the tray with the seatbacks.
2. If the tray is not in the desired location, simply lift tray off the seatback and realign.

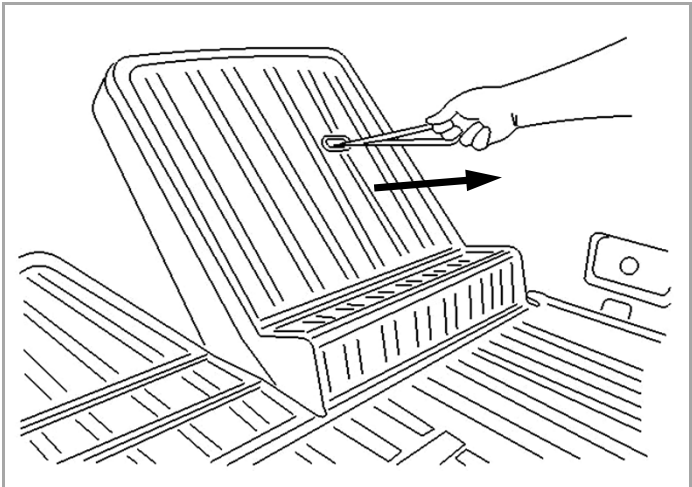

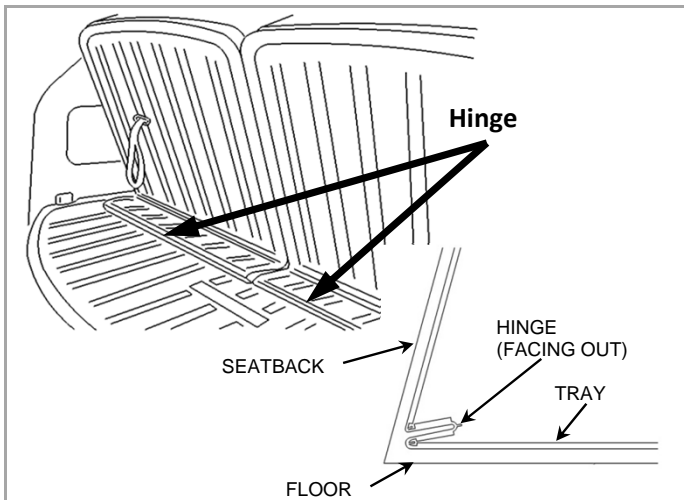
1. Attach the remaining securing pads by firmly pressing each upper panel down against the seatbacks as shown.
2. Repeat on the other side.

1. Slowly return the seatback to the upright position ensuring the tray folds to the outward position as shown in step 11.

1. Ensure the folding hinge is facing outward when first placing the seatback in the upright position.

Care and Cleaning

NOTE

The tray can be wiped, swept, lightly vacuumed, or cleaned with water or soap and water. Do not use petroleum-based solvents for cleaning.
