Adhesives used in this product are sensitive to temperature during installation, only install this product to the vehicle if the temperature is between (60° - 80°F \ 15° - 27°C). Installing the parts to the vehicle outside of this temperature may lead to a reduced level of performance.

Installation of all parts should not occur in direct sunlight or if the vehicle has been parked in direct sunlight and is hot as a result. Both the parts and the vehicle should be at the same temperature (60° - 80°F \ 15° - 27°C) during the installation to ensure maximum adhesion.

Read the entire installation instructions prior to beginning the installation of this accessory.


Make sure the vehicle is completely clean before the accessory is installed.
