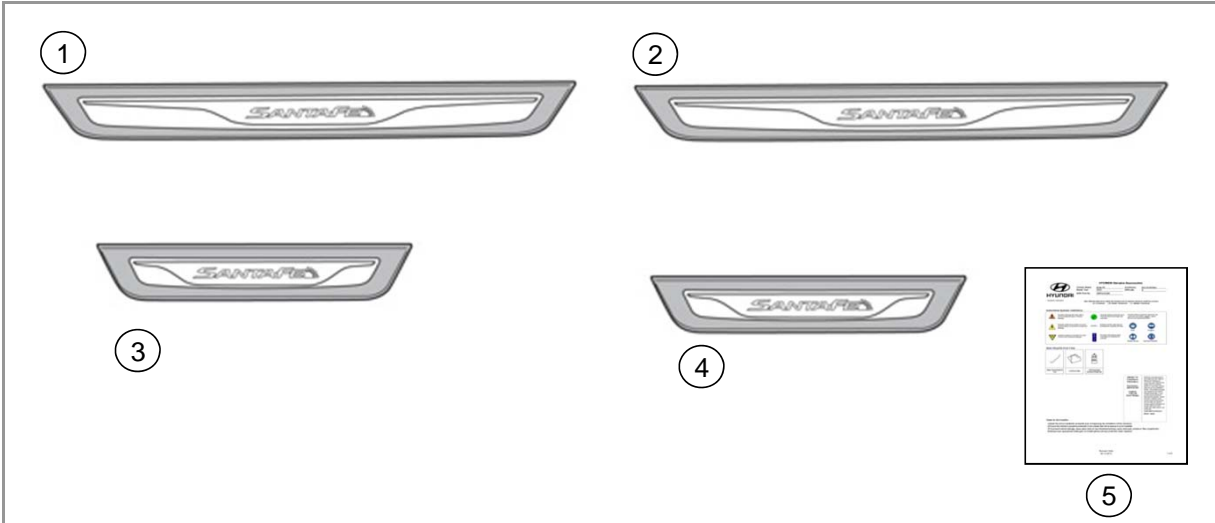

- 4) Always wear appropriate safety gear to include gloves and eye protection when required.

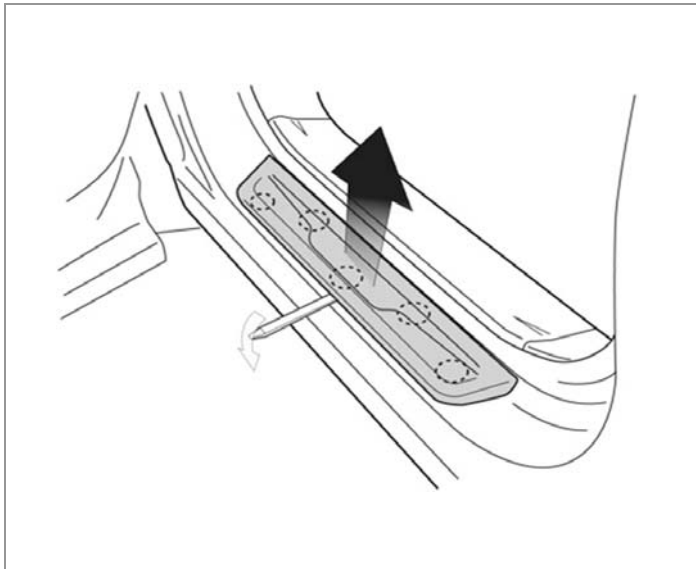

Nylon Panel Removal Tool

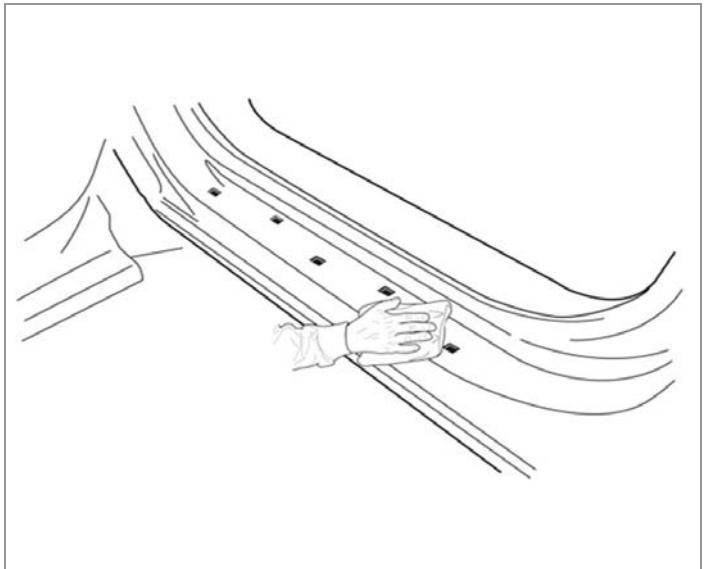

NOTE

1. Using a nylon panel removal tool, gently pull up to disengage the five (5) retention clips of the left front (LF) OEM door scuff plate and remove from the side panel of the vehicle.
2. Discard the OEM door scuff plate.



Do not scratch or damage the side panel when removing the OEM door scuff plate.

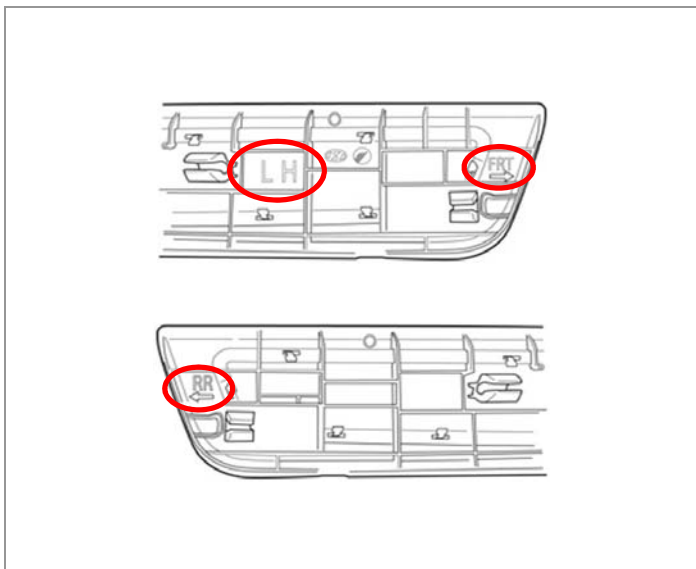


50/50 Isopropyl Alcohol (70%) & Water Mix and Lint Free Cloth

NOTE

1. Using a 50/50 isopropyl alcohol (70%) & water mix and a lint free cloth, thoroughly clean the side panel as shown.



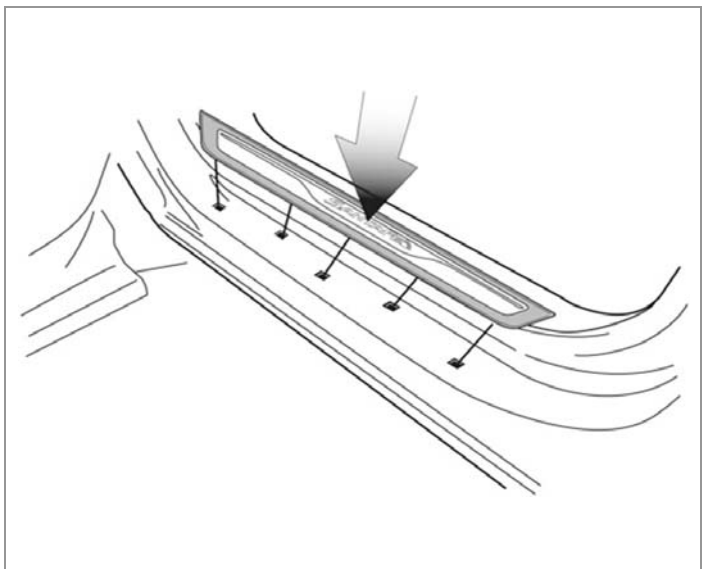

1. Identify the left front (LF) door scuff plate (long) by the "LH" marking indicated on the backside as shown.
2. Orient the "FRT" and "RR" arrows of the door scuff plate with the front and rear of the vehicle.



Make sure to correctly identify and orient the door scuff plate.

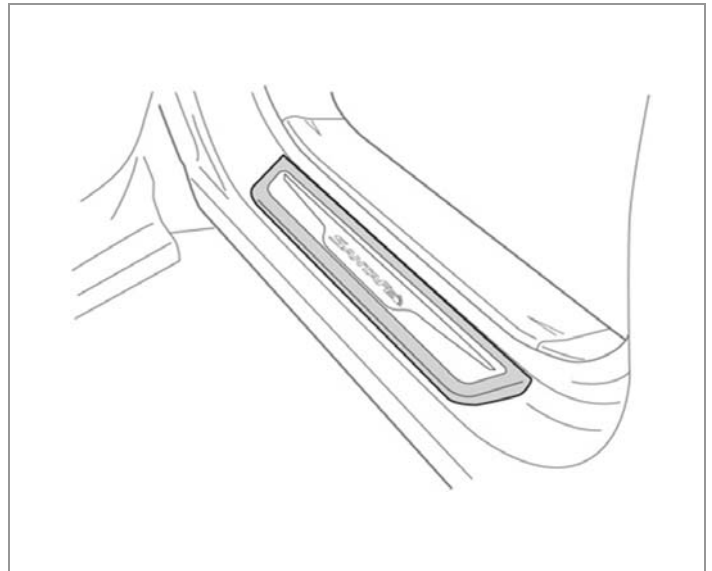
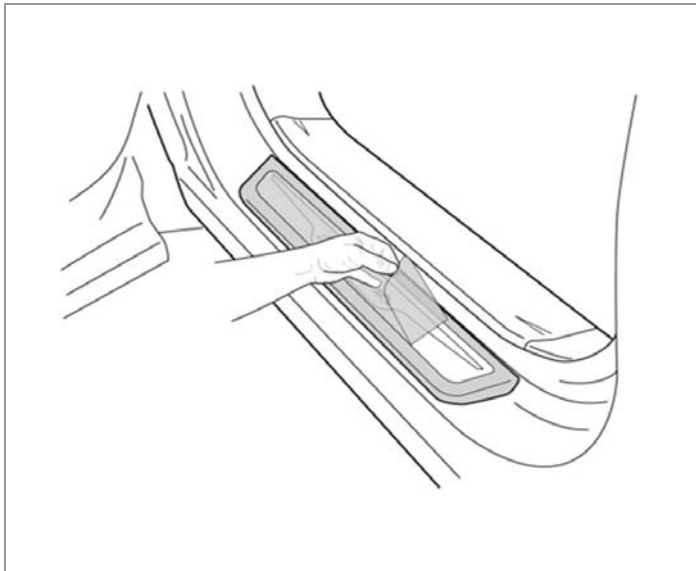

1. Align the five (5) clips of the left front (LF) door scuff plate (long) to the five (5) front left hand (LH) clip holes of the vehicle side panel as shown.
2. Gently push down on each of the five (5) clip locations to securely fasten the door scuff plate to the vehicle.




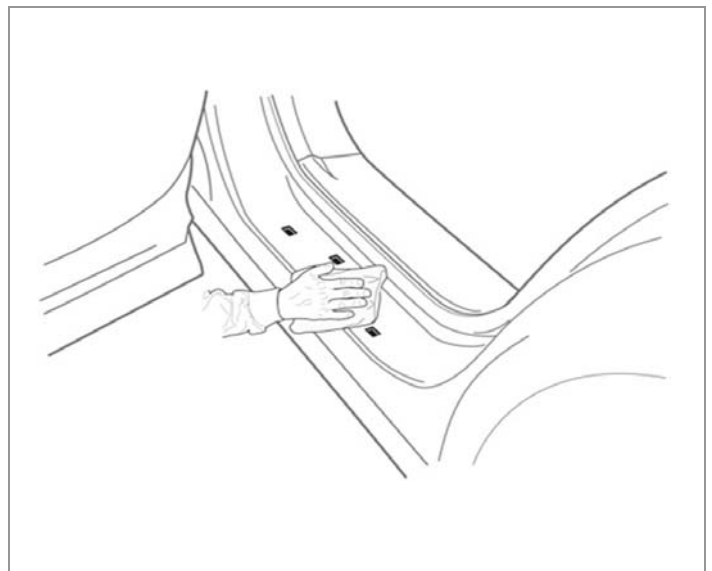
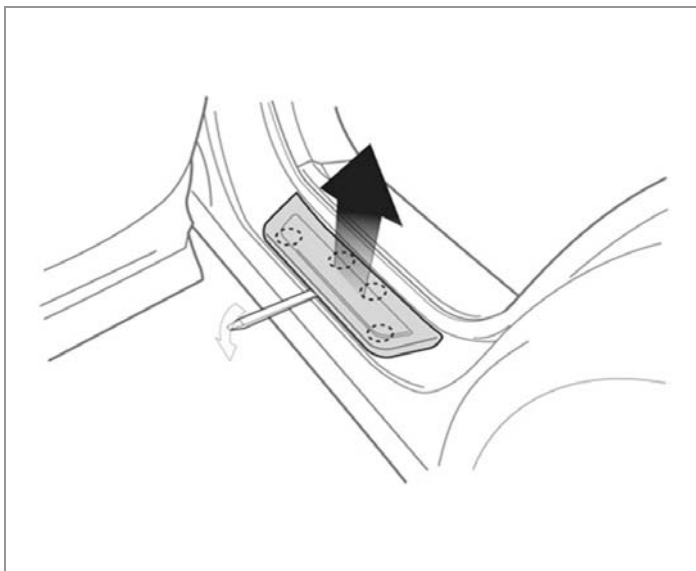
Make sure all clips on the door scuff plate are fully inserted into the clip holes of the side panel.
