


FMVSS 110 Compliance Information

All dealers must determine if the Net weight they have added in the form of all options or accessories, when added to the weight of all Port/Dealer Installed options or accessories, exceeds the lesser of 1.5% of GVWR or 100 lbs. If the additional weight does exceed the lesser of the indicated thresholds, a "Load Carrying Capacity Reduced" label must be installed. A black, fine-point, indelible marker must be used to write by hand onto the label, the reduced carrying capacity in kilograms or pounds, which is the total weight of all added options and accessories. Notes to the installer:


- 1) Read the entire installation instructions prior to beginning the installation of this accessory.
- Make sure the vehicle is completely clean before the accessory is installed.
- 3) Ensure the vehicle is properly protected in the area(s) that the accessory is to be installed.
- 4) To prevent vehicle damage, never place tools on top of painted surfaces, seats, dash pad, console or floor carpet/mats.
- 5) Always wear appropriate safety gear to include gloves and safety glasses when required.
- 6) Alcohol, Soap & Water Mixture: Mix 8 oz. of water, 8 oz. alcohol (70% isopropyl) & 1 ml of baby shampoo in a trigger type spray bottle marked "SLIP". Note: The above listed solution has been formulated for use where ambient & vehicle surface temperatures are within a range of 65°F to 90°F. If temperatures exceed this range, add additional shampoo in increments of 1 ml to aid in alignment.
- 7) Install this product while observing all warnings and precautions stated in these installation instructions.
- VERY IMPORTANT: Thoroughly clean rear bumper area with soap and water. If contaminants are found, refer to Hyundai Technical Service Bulletin 99-99-001 to determine the correct repair procedure.
- VERY IMPORTANT: Ambient temperature of the rear bumper area and vehicle must be 65°F to 90°F at the time of installation and for two hours
- 10) Parts storage should be at room temperature and in a clean dry place. Care should be taken to avoid a dusty environment.
- 11) Place a large towel or pad on the ground to catch wetting mixture and avoid slippery floor.



A Alcohol, Soap & Water (SLIP Mixture)

Inspection Procedure

N O T Inspect for proper fit, bubbles and debris trapped underneath the Rear Bumper Applique from more than an arm's length.

NOTE: Experienced installers may attempt to locally lift up the Rear Bumper Applique and reinstall.

* Appropriate tools used for Applique removals are available to customers from specialty retailers.



Hands or any tools used to lift the Rear Bumper Applique, must be saturated with SLIP mixture. Dry hands or tools may mar the applique.

Visual Check

Item to be Checked Result



Use only the handling tabs on the Rear Bumper Applique. Pay special attention to not get any fingerprints or dirt on the Rear Bumper Applique.



Make sure Rear Bumper Applique is fully adhered.



Make sure no air bubbles are trapped under Rear Bumper Applique.



Check for bubbles. If bubbles are found, re-wet Rear Bumper Applique with SLIP Mixture and using a Squeegee with Sleeve, push/pull/remove bubbles to the closest edge of the Rear Bumper Applique.



Make sure Rear Bumper Applique is free of any remaining adhesive after installation. Clean the Rear Bumper Applique with soap and water if necessary.



If an installation error occurs, i.e., scratched / marred Rear Bumper Applique, dirt / debris under Rear Bumper Applique, crooked installation, etc., installer should remove, discard and replace the Rear Bumper Applique.

No dirt or fingerprints on Rear Bumper Applique.

Rear Bumper Applique is not lifting and is fully adhered. Take special care to make sure all edges are fully adhered.

Rear Bumper Applique is installed correctly.

No bubbles present.

No adhesive remaining on Rear Bumper Applique.

Rear Bumper Applique is installed correctly.
